EARLY INTERVENTION

Program providing service coordination and additional supports for families with infants and toddlers (birth through age 3) with developmental delays.

- **EI** Early Intervention: Program providing service coordination and additional supports for families with infants & toddlers (birth through age 3) with I/DD.

INDIVIDUAL FAMILY SERVICE PLAN

Plan for infants and toddlers in the Early Intervention Program. It details current levels of development and outcomes to be reviewed at minimum every 6 months.

- PAR Prior Authorization Request
- **PART C** Federal funding for infant/toddler programs through the Division of Intellectual and Developmental Disabilities; also known in Colorado as Early Childhood Colorado.
- **PASA** Program Approved Service Agency: An agency contracted to provide Medicaid Waiver services (residential, day program, behavioral) to individuals as outlined in their Service Plan.
- PCP Primary Care Physician

- PM Program Manager: A position that manages a residential, day service or work facility program for PASAs; PM indicates a level of management within the CM, CO, and EI departments, usually responsible for the supervision of Service Coordinator, Case Manager, and Administrative level staff.
- **PT** Physical Therapy/Therapist
- **RMHS** Rocky Mountain Human Services
- **SC** Service Coordinator: Title for staff in the Community Outreach & Early Intervention Departments that support with coordination and monitoring of services to individuals and their families.
