I/DD	Intellectual/Developmental Disability: A funding or legislative term for children over age 5 & adults. Includes intellectual disability (ID) as well as other neurological and physical diagnoses.

IFSP	Individual Family Service Plan: Plan for infants and toddlers in the Early Intervention Program. It details current levels of development and outcomes/goals to be reviewed every 6 months.

PASA	Program Approved Service Agency: An agency contracted to provide Medicaid Waiver services (residential, day program, behavioral) to individuals as outlined in their Service Plan.

INDIVIDUAL FAMILY SERVICE PLAN

Plan for infants and toddlers in the Early Intervention Program. It details current levels of development and outcomes to be reviewed at minimum every 6 months.

PM	Program Manager: A position that manages a residential, day service or work facility program for PASAs; PM indicates a level of management within the CM, CO, and EI departments, usually responsible for the supervision of Service Coordinator, Case Manager, and Administrative level staff.

SC	Service Coordinator: Title for staff in the Community Outreach & Early Intervention Departments that support with coordination and monitoring of services to individuals and their families.

TANF	Temporary Assistance to Needy Families
TCM	Targeted Case Management: Services provided by a CCB that include facilitating enrollment; locating, coordinating, and monitoring needed developmental disability services; and coordinating with other non-developmental disability funded services.
TRE	The Resource Exchange
